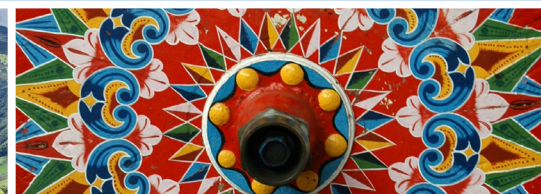
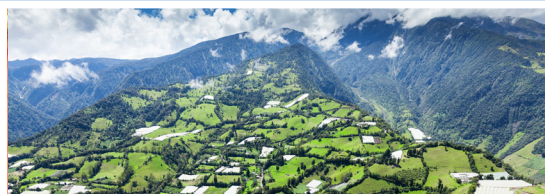
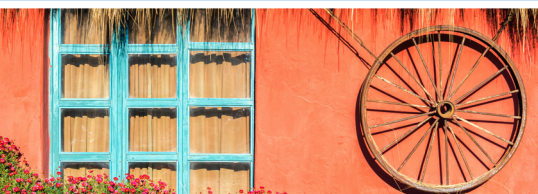


API SUMMER SERVICE-LEARNING PROGRAMS

THE BASICS

- Spend your time volunteering at local projects and completing online coursework (taught in English)
- Earn 1-3 U.S. semester credits for your academic work
- Live with a local host family, practice your Spanish, and immerse yourself in the culture

REQUIREMENTS

- 18+ years old
- Minimum 2.75 G.P.A.
- Open to rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors
- Open to all levels of Spanish speakers

SUMMER 1-3 SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS

Students who choose to participate in the Service-Learning program with API will divide their time between volunteering at local projects and completing online coursework. Students will **learn by doing** and by **reflecting on their actions**, all the while **contributing to the long-term and strategic goals of a community partner abroad**. Students will serve abroad under the guidance of a local site supervisor and a U.S.-based faculty member or assessment coordinator.

Project areas involve working with children in schools or with children and the elderly in social aid projects, as well as working on a sustainable farm on the outskirts of San José.

QUITO, ECUADOR

Project areas involve working with children in varied social aid projects.

COURSE INFORMATION

SERVICE-LEARNING 101: INTERNATIONAL EDITION

This course explores the role of culture and service in shaping students personally and professionally for their future roles in both their careers and their communities.

Students will:

- learn about intercultural communication and competence, as well as cultural understanding;
- engage with underserved and under-represented populations; and
- gain soft skills through the challenges and opportunities of living and working abroad.

Students will be engaged in ongoing service through partnerships with community agencies as an integral part of the course.

The course integrates three main areas of focus:

- engagement in service activities with a selected community partner in a mutually beneficial relationship based on a spirit of collaboration;
- reflection upon larger issues that affect communities through readings, journal entries and discussion; and
- integration of community engagement and academic learning through discussions, papers, presentations and experiential activities.
